# **New programming**

The creation of 2 new programs to support the membership in different ways were spearheaded in the Fall of 2024:

- INSTRUCTOR MENTORSHIP PROGRAM: a volunteer-based program for all CASI instructors that aims to provide mentorship to instructors of any identity, with special emphasis on historically excluded groups
- **DIVERSITY ADVISORY GROUP**: exists in an advisory role providing support to the association on matters regarding diversity, equity and inclusion (DEI).

# **Scholarships**

100% of the CASI Scholarship budget was used in the 2024-25 season.

- 24 Scholarships granted
- 21 at \$200/each, 1 at \$400 and 1 at \$159.85

## **Pro-deals**

Our pro-deal offerings are our #1 member retention strategy. Growing this program and increasing it's value and offerings to the association should remain a priority.

- 69 brands currently available
  - **16 new brands** added in 2024-25, including notable brands like Patagonia, North Face, Telus and Yonex
- New in 2024-25: minimum discount of 25% was implemented
- Average discount across brands was 35% in 2024-25



# **Resort Support Program**

The RSP was implemented in the 2023/24 season as a pilot and continued as an official program in the 2024/25 season. It was developed to support the development of instructors working in the industry by providing 40% off registration for higher (next) level certifications. Instructors apply for vouchers through their snow schools and can be used for any course CASI offers, including any certification level, exam/retest days and Evaluator Development.

• CASI's total investment: \$84,000
